## THE FOUR MAIN TYPES OF LETTUCE:

- Romaine: grows in tall, loose elongated heads with thick ribs in the leaves; toward the heart, the leaves are small, yellow, and sweet.
- **Crisphead:** grows in tight round heads that look like cabbage, with crunchy leaves (iceberg is a classic example).
- **Butterhead:** also grow in round heads, but the leaves are looser and have a softer, smoother texture than crisphead; butter is often referred to as Boston or Bibb lettuce. (Little gem is a cross between romaine and butterhead.)
- Looseleaf (or leaf lettuce): grows in a loose rosette of tender leaves off the stem; red leaf and green leaf are examples of looseleaf.

## THE GRADE

## All of Baldor's lettuce is U.S. No 1, which means the following:

- 1. Similar varietal characteristics, fresh, green, not soft, not burst
- 2. Free from decay, Russet spotting, doubles
- 3. Free from injury by tip burn, downy mildew, field freezing, discoloration, or damage by any other cause
- 4. Heads are well trimmed unless specified as closely trimmed

Every box of lettuce has coding on the side; this example from Andy Boy can help you understand what it all means.
